






#### Blended Double Consonants (pp. 4, 7, 28, 31, 52, 55)

- Play the audio CD. Have students repeat the double consonant.
- Check that students can make the sound of the double consonant, especially for r and l.
- · Have students write the blended double consonant what they heard.
- · Have students do the listening practice below to check spelling and sound of the double consonants.
